- Discussion forum for people to exchange ideas on social entrepreneurship


We will take it step by step and show you where to find each section and how to navigate.




To begin with, this is how the platform looks when you access the link. In the first part you will find more information about the EnMind project, its purpose and how it's been implemented.



At the bottom of the page, you can find more about the **project** partners. Click on the logo of the organization and be redirected to their web page.




After you have familiarized yourself with the project, start discovering the resources and opportunities that EnMind offers you.




From here you can access the **entrepreneurship courses**. Click on one of the boxes according to your preferences, if you want to take a face-to-face or online course.

In the next section you can watch videos made within the project. Click on them and find out more about the actions we carried out. You can also follow us on YouTube to learn more about the events we organize.




If you scroll down, you will find our written resources that we have created together with our partners and are available in English, Romanian, Italian, Polish and Turkish.

You will find more extensive materials, the Curriculum Framework, this User Guide a Magazine with workshop scenarios intended for entrepreneurship education.


And below the three newsletters where you can find out about the evolution of the project and the activities carried out in the partner countries.




Leaflets translated into all partner languages were created at the beginning of the project to inform and promote the EnMind project. You can access them from here.



Then, the **EnMind course material** is presented to you. It contains 12 modules and to start, click on one of the boxes to reach the content.




As you can see, the course is available in English, Romanian, Turkish, Polish and Italian. For the course content to be translated, click on the box with the language you prefer.




At the end of each module, all the course modules are listed. The 12 modules are user-friendly and it is really easy to jump from one module to the other in all the project languages.


Just click on the module title listed.

Share your opinion or ask a question in the box below. Complete with your name and e-mail address. The e-mail address will not be displayed, but the name will. Then click Submit Comment.






Social Entrepreneurship Course


If you want to follow the complete course and get certified, you can easily navigate from the online platform to the Moodle course.


In Moodle, you can self-register and self-enrol in the course language version of your choice. For more details on how to use Moodle, a dedicated user guide is available in each course without registration.




If you do not have an account, under the log in button there is the sign in button. Complete all the fields and create a new account with your e-mail address. You can also log in very simply through your Google or Facebook account.



Once registered, the course categories will appear. Click on Entrepreneurial Mindset - EnMind in EN, RO, IT, PL, TR



Choose the course in the desired language and click on its box.




To start the course, don't forget to enroll using the button in the top bar. If you don't enroll, you have no way to complete the course and get the certificate




Once enrolled, a lot of resources are waiting for you:



- Case studies




Introduce yourself and interact with other students through the forum section. Follow the instructions that will be given to you and continue.
