11th May, Poland

Instytut Badan i Innowacji w Edukacji from Poland organized an event focused on a toolkit on social entrepreneurship. At the event participated 11 young people, learners, youth workers and trainers. Prof. Luis Ochoa Siguencia from INBIE delivered the workshop and tested the toolkit on social entrepreneurship with activity participants. The purpose of this event was to evaluate and validate the content of the toolkit, collect feedback and suggestions from target groups after the pilot test session, and analyze test results to improve and fine-tune the toolkit.


Female entrepreneurship for youth

25th May, Turkey

On 25th May 2022, an event about how to Explore the Business Ideas within the Erasmus+ Partnership Entrepreneurial Mindset took place at Eyüpsultan Vatan Anatolian High School. The event was organized by the Governorship of Istanbul with the aim to support participants searching for a good social enterprise example. The objectives of this event was to analyze social enterprise examples in all aspects. During the activity the participants were divided into groups. To begin with, everyone had to make sure they had an internet connection. Then, they had to look for information about two social enterprises in their country and / or region that created a social impact. Conclusions on social entrepreneurship were drawn at the end.













Transnational meetings

10th June, Poland

The third transnational project meeting within the Erasmus+Partnership Entrepreneurial Mindset was organized by INBIE and took place in Częstochowa, Poland.

In the first part, we talked about methodology of pilot testing and evaluation of the elaborated Toolkit. Each partner proposed a way to promote piloting, recruit and collect feedback.

In the second part of meeting, we talked about the strategy of dissemination and we agreed on the guidelines to prepare and transmit key messages. The last part of the event was dedicated to planning the next project activity, the Short-Term Joint Staff Training on social entrepreneurship scheduled to take place in Istanbul, Turkey.





27th June, Turkey

Partners from Turkey, Istanbul Valiligi, organised **a Short-Term Joint Staff Training** on social entrepreneurship within the Erasmus+ Partnership Entrepreneurial Mindset.

- In the first day, we talked about the theoretical part, guidance for trainers and youth workers to use our platform on social entrepreneurship, and practical activities. Also, how they can use "MOOC on social entrepreneurship" to train, guide, and evaluate the learning outcomes of young people.
- In the second day, we did a workshop about theoretical aspects of social entrepreneurship and practical activities. These included theoretical aspects on how to create the perfect Elevator Pitch and practical activity with the title *Pitch your start-up*.
- In the last day, we continued with theoretical aspects on defining a business model & practical activity and deployment of activity results.
- The last subject was about the skills and competencies for trainers and Youth workers to encourage social entrepreneurship. The training was closed with conclusions and evaluation.

4th August, Romania

The fourth transnational project meeting was provided by TEAM4Excellence and took place in Constanta, Romania. Participants from all partner organisations analysed the project results, being more focused on the feedback we received after the multiplier events and the Toolkit. We've talked about the developing process of the EnMind platform which includes a MOOC (Massive Open Online Course) on Social Entrepreneurship.

After that, we reviewed the strategy for dissemination, aiming to promote our results in more effective way.

At the end, we established the following actions in the project and we shared best practices and then drew conclusions.



The **EnMind platform** are currently being reviewed. It will serve as an open education digital platform for the provision of the training material developed throughout the project. Through this digital platform, trainings will be conducted more efficiently, by overcoming physical and time limitations.
